



Each student is expected to come along with some items that may provide minimum comfort and stress-free stay in the hall of residence. The following items are strongly recommended.

- i. Pillow
- ii. Pillow Cases
- iii. Blanket
- iv. Bed sheet – 4” x 7”
- v. Mosquito Net
- vi. Set of Plastic Cutlery
- vii. Plastic Buckets
- viii. Padlock
- ix. Torchlight and Batteries
- x. Hangers
- xi. School Bag
- xii. Raincoat or Umbrella
- xiii. Toiletries
- xiv. Reading Lamp
- xv. Laptop PC
- xvi. Feeding/upkeep Allowance
- xvii. Writing materials

The following items are prohibited in the Halls of Residence and anywhere on the Campus of Mountain Top University, and shall not be found in the possession of a student of the University.

- i. Indian Hemp/Cigarettes
- ii. Charms or fetish objects of any kind
- iii. Hard drugs such as cocaine, heroin and other illicit drugs
- iv. Alcoholic drinks
- v. Lethal weapons (guns, bullets, explosives, etc) or injections
- vi. Bottle, knives, fork
- vii. Fireworks (knock-out) of any kind



- viii. Inflammables and open flame including kerosene lamp, gas, candles, matches, lighter.
- ix. Cooking utensils such as hot plates, rice cookers, toasters, micro waves, electric boiling ring, saucepans, blenders
- x. Electrical appliances and electronics such as refrigerators, grillers, hair dryers, straighteners, TV sets, Video machines, tapes, DVD and VCD players, Computer game (play station), TV card, antennas.
- xi. Any items meant for sale or business activities.
- xii. Raw food items.
- xiii. Jeans, chinos, corduroy and diabolic materials.
- xiv. Ungodly musical tapes, CDs, and mobile phones.
- xv. Weight or shot put.
- xvi. Condom and contraceptives
- xvii. All forms of cult-related materials as bracelets, amulets, talisman, occultic rings, waist beads, bands, etc.
- xviii. Materials that have diabolical connotations.
- xix. Unconventional clothing materials carrying inexplicable signs and symbols.
- xx. Signs and emblems of known cults or secret societies/organisations in other Universities/Institutions in Nigeria or elsewhere.
- xxi. Body signs such as incisions, lacerations/cuts, piercing/perforations of parts of the body, strange shaping of beards/haircut, etc.
- xxii. Other contraband items that may be specified or published from time to time.
